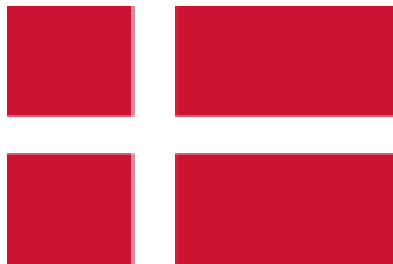
Czech Republic

Estonia



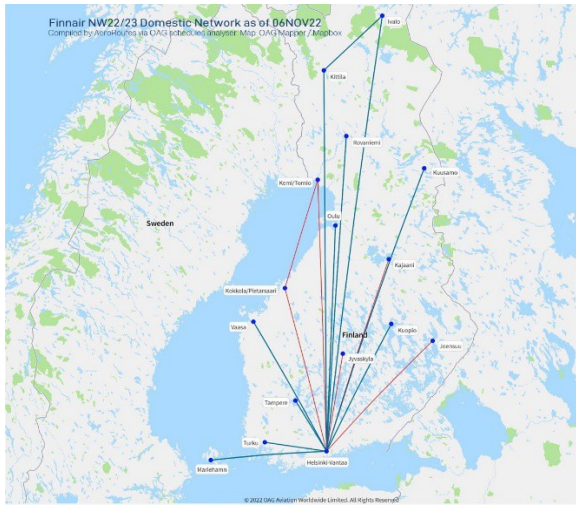

Finland

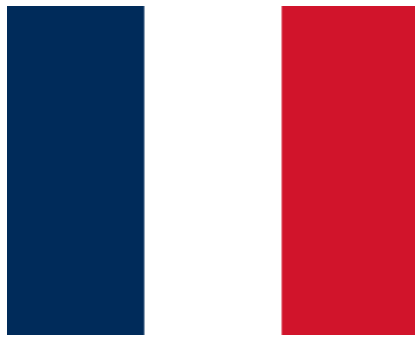

France



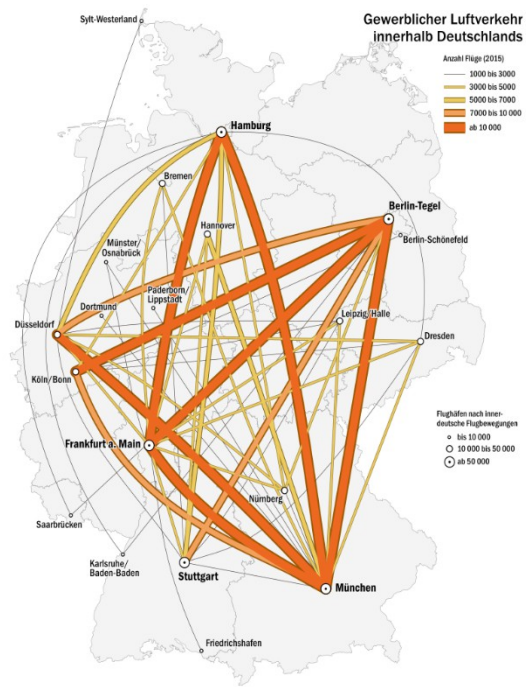

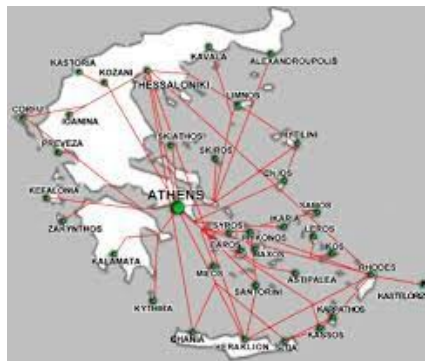
Germany

Ireland

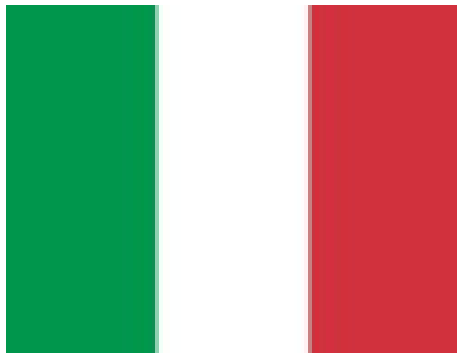

Italy



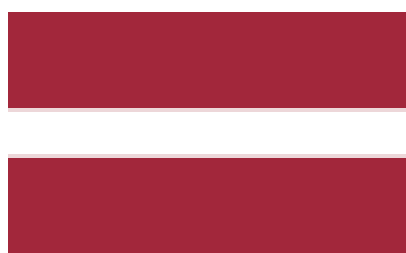

Portugal



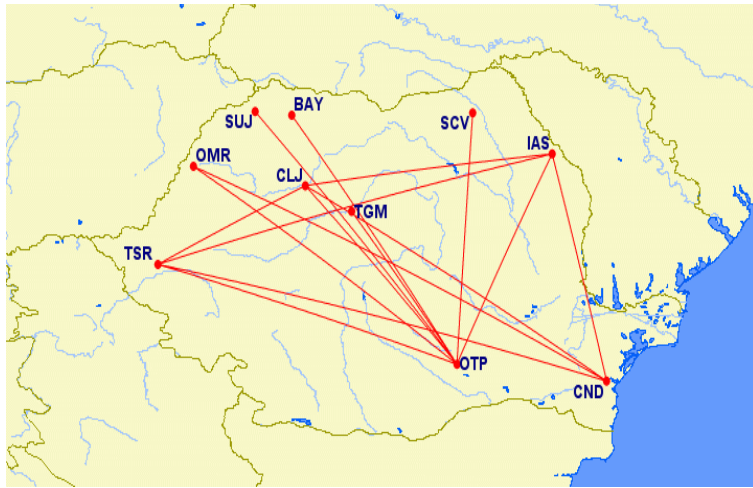

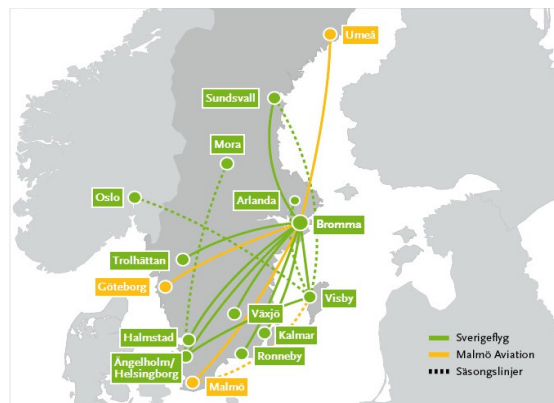
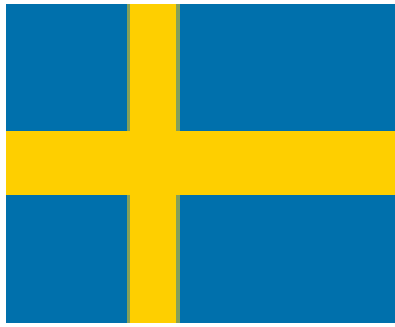
